Learning Challenges Connected with OCD

<i>Concentration / Participation</i>	May find it hard to concentrate on what an instructor or peer is saying; disconnection; nonresponsive; avoidance of difficult situations, topics, or activities
<i>Assignment Completion</i>	Can struggle with completion of a task or project; seeks perfection in all assignments and actions; second-guessing work and doubting comprehension; get stuck on a specific task or activity
<i>Assessments</i>	Difficulty with multiple-choice questions; hyper focused on the correct way to complete an assessment; difficulty with timed assessments; challenged with being prepared enough
<i>Reading</i>	Struggle to focus on the text meaning; distracted by worry or rituals; multiple re-reads might be necessary to fully understand concepts
<i>Math</i>	Certain numbers can be triggering; constant re-doing or re-checking problems; memorization can be challenging
<i>Writing</i>	Excessive erasing or re-writing things; struggling to find the perfect sentence or way of saying something; handwriting assignments can be hard; getting started is a barrier
